Canvas – A modern Learning Management System for MIT

Stellar/LMOD is not going away, but there are good reasons to transition to Canvas:

- For Fall 2020 classes: every academic department has one or more MIT students to help you with migration, setup, optimization now; time-limited resource
- Canvas' Speedgrader can speed up grading substantially: text/drawing/audio/video feedback, download or grade in place, dynamic rubric to speed & improve consistency
- Content creation: quizzes, modules, pages, video
- Zoom, Piazza, Dropbox, Slack, Gradescope integration now; other tools tbd
- Integrated calendar of *all* class meetings & assignments for each student
- Robust mobile access for students & faculty
- 24/7/365 phone, chat & email support
