We are particularly interested in innovations rooted in MIT's research and practice with the potential for generating high impact on higher education globally. Awards range from \$10K-80K for the duration of up to 12 months.

• Workforce Learning Innovation Research Grants (reviewed quarterly)

We provide seed funding for research projects that will improve workforce learning around the world. Ideal projects will improve advice, learning, assessment, or credentialing for individuals, or will help organizations or governments to assist workers in these ways. Awards range from \$20K-\$70K.
