Summary: SMART seeks concept ideas for multi-investigator (5-8 MIT and 5-8 Singapore Pl's) large-scale research and development programs with the potential for significant societal and/or economic impact in 10-15 years (note that MIT and Singapore investigators need not be identified at this time). Successful programs are funded initially for five years and possibly an additional five years, if there is satisfactory progress.
