Texas A&M-Commerce University still has Graduate Teaching Assistantship positions available beginning in the fall 2022 semester. If you know of any students that are still looking for a graduate program in physics please forward them this email.

A&M-Commerce is a regional university of ~12,000 students located in northeastern Texas and offers a terminal Master's degree in physics and for those interested in astronomy your thesis work can be done in physics, astronomy or astrophysics. The department has 11 full-time faculty members, 3 astronomers, 3 astrophysicists, 2 surface physicists and 3 specialists in physics education. The teaching assistantship position requires students to teach undergraduate labs and/or help with grading and teaching of undergraduate courses up to 20 hours a week. For this work students will receive a stipend each semester along with 6 hours of tuition remission for each semester during the two year program.
